

The Choir and Tenby

Tenby Male Choir is a relatively young choir, having been formed in 1975. In the 35 years of its existence, it has developed strong bonds within the local community. The choir gives about 25 formal concerts each year, more than half of which are to raise money for local and national charities.

The choir also encourages young musicians to develop their skills, not least by giving them opportunities to give solo performances in its concerts. We are proud to be part of the wider male voice choir community, competing in eisteddfodau and giving joint concerts with



other choirs. We have regularly participated in the festival of massed choirs in the Royal Albert Hall.

In addition to its other activities, the choristers, their families and friends meet socially on a regular basis, for events ranging from informal gatherings to organised trips and holidays.
